



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

Indusliga, a sports organization engaged in football training, coaching, and development programs, having its office at **B6 Veena Nagar Sukhliya Indore -452010**, hereinafter referred to as "Indusliga" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors and assigns);

AND

Oriental University, Indore, having its campus at Indore (M.P.), hereinafter referred to as "Oriental University" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its administrators and successors).

Indusliga and Oriental University are hereinafter individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

1. Purpose of Collaboration

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaboration for football (soccer) training and coaching programs to be conducted at Oriental University campus by Indusliga, for university students and eligible participants from nearby areas.

2. Scope of Activities

- ❖ Regular football coaching and practice sessions
- ❖ Player development programs
- ❖ Preparation of players for All India and West Zone tournaments
- ❖ Football camps, matches, and related activities as planned by Indusliga

3. Profit Sharing

1. For Oriental University students, the profit-sharing ratio shall be:

60% – Indusliga

40% – Oriental University

2. For external participants (maximum 50) / children under 17 years of age from the surrounding area, the profit-sharing ratio will be as follows:

75% – Indusliga

25% – Oriental University

4. Fee Collection & Transfer

1. Fees from Oriental University students shall be collected by Oriental University.

2. The collected amount shall be transferred to the Indusliga bank account within 7 (seven) days from the date of collection.



3. Indusliga shall independently communicate with students regarding monthly, quarterly, half-yearly, or annual fee payments.

4. Oriental University shall not be liable for delays or defaults in student fee payments.

In case any player fails to pay the required fees timely, monthly, partly, yearly, or in full, the responsibility shall lie solely with the individual player and/or Indusliga. Oriental University shall not be responsible for discontinuation, disputes, penalties, or any consequences arising due to non-payment or delayed payment of fees.

5. Commencement of Classes

Soccer classes shall commence immediately after the signing of MOU.

6. Promotion & Support

Oriental University shall assist Indusliga in promoting the football program within its internal communities, campus, and compounds.

7. Infrastructure & Equipment

1. Oriental University shall provide access to available facilities such as:

- ❖ Football ground
- ❖ Nets and basic infrastructure

2. Indusliga shall arrange and manage:

- ❖ Training equipment
- ❖ Cones, nets, balls, and other required items
- ❖ Daily practice sessions

3. Oriental University shall provide one secure room with lock and key for storage of Indusliga equipment.

8. Participation of Outside Students

1. Oriental University, under the rules and supervision of Indusliga, will allow children under the age of 17 from the surrounding areas to participate in a training program, with a maximum of 50 participants.

2. All participants participating outside the premises of Oriental University under Indusliga shall be governed by the disciplinary rules and regulations of Indusliga. Any act of misconduct, indiscipline, or violation of rules shall be entirely handled by Indusliga, and Oriental University shall not be responsible or liable for any such incidents or consequences.

9. Fee Structure & Offers

1. Soccer fees shall always be introduced with special offer pricing, such as:

- Regular monthly fee: ₹2,500
- Special offer for Oriental University students: ₹1,500 per month
- Annual fee example:

I. Regular annual fee: ₹30,000

II. Introductory offer: ₹18,000 per annum

2. Early-bird registration discounts and other promotional offers may be introduced by Indusliga from time to time.

3. Final fee structures (monthly / quarterly / half-yearly / annually) shall be mutually discussed and finalized as required.



10. Payment Mode

Fees shall be accepted in advance on a:

- Monthly
- Quarterly
- Half-yearly
- Annual basis

11. Refund Policy

Once fees are paid, no refund or claim shall be entertained if a student does not attend classes for any reason.

12. Class Schedule & Holidays

1. Relaxation or off-days during the training period shall be communicated by Indusliga from time to time.

2. No soccer classes shall be conducted on:

- Sundays
- Public holidays

3. Soccer matches are exempted from this restriction and may be planned solely by Indusliga.

13. Discipline & Compliance

Indusliga shall strictly adhere to Oriental University's rules and regulations related to:

- Ground usage
- Discipline
- Security
- Professional conduct

14. Duration of Agreement

This MoU shall be valid for a minimum period of two (2) years from the date of signing, unless terminated earlier by mutual consent.

15. Termination

Either Party may terminate this MoU with written notice of 90 days, subject to settlement of pending dues and obligations.

16. Miscellaneous

Any amendments or additions to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by both Parties. This MoU does not create any employer-employee or partnership relationship between the Parties.



17. Jurisdiction

This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India, and courts at Indore, Madhya Pradesh, shall have jurisdiction.

18. Liability Clause

Indusliga shall be responsible for conducting football training sessions in a professional and safe manner.

29. Injury Disclaimer

1. Football is a physically demanding sport and involves inherent risks of injury.
2. All participants (or parents/guardians in case of minors) shall participate at their own risk and shall be deemed to have voluntarily accepted such risks.
3. Oriental University & Indusliga shall not be liable for any injury, illness, disability, or death arising during or after football training, practice sessions, camps, or matches conducted in the ground.
4. Indusliga shall ensure that participants are informed of safety guidelines and basic injury-prevention practices and take undertaking from every players and one copy submitted to university.

20. Medical Responsibility

1. Participants are responsible for ensuring they are medically fit to participate in football activities.
2. Indusliga shall not be responsible for any existing / pre-existing medical conditions of participants.
3. In case of injury during training or a match, first aid will be provided by Indusliga and Oriental University jointly.
4. In view of post-COVID medical considerations, it is hereby clearly understood and agreed that Indusliga Club shall collect a written undertaking and a valid medical fitness certificate from each and every player (team and individual) prior to their participation.

21. Insurance Clause

1. Indusliga may, at its discretion, obtain appropriate sports or personal accident insurance for coaches and staff.
2. Participants are strongly advised to maintain their own personal medical and accident insurance.
3. Oriental University shall not be obligated to provide insurance coverage for participants enrolled in the Indusliga football program.

22. Force Majeure

Neither Party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance of obligations due to events beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, government restrictions, pandemics, strikes, or unforeseen circumstances.



During such events, training schedules may be modified or suspended without liability to either Party.

23. No Guarantee Clause

1. Indusliga does not guarantee selection into professional teams, tournaments, or employment opportunities.
2. Performance improvement and selection outcomes depend on individual skill, effort, fitness, and external selection criteria.

24. Child Protection & Conduct (for Minors)

1. Indusliga shall ensure proper professional conduct while training minors under 17 years of age.
2. Oriental University shall not be responsible for supervision of minors during training hours conducted by Indusliga.
3. Parents/guardians must ensure timely pickup/drop-off of minors.

25. Limitation of Liability

In no event shall Oriental University be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising from this collaboration, including loss of opportunity or reputation.
