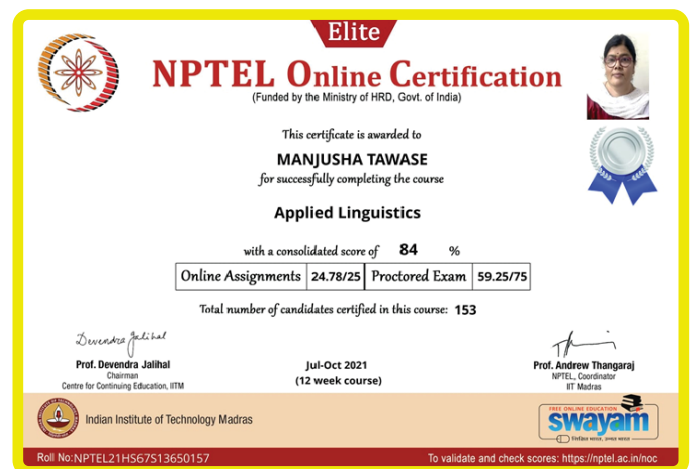

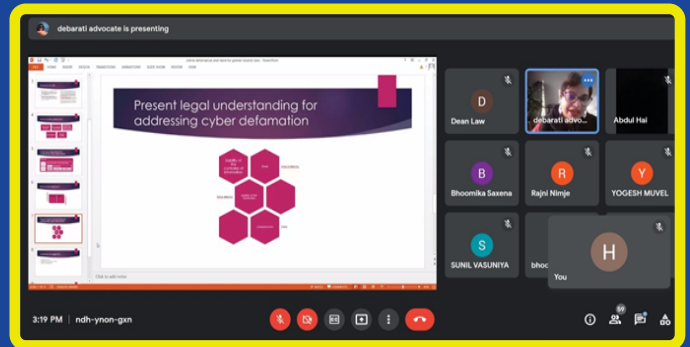
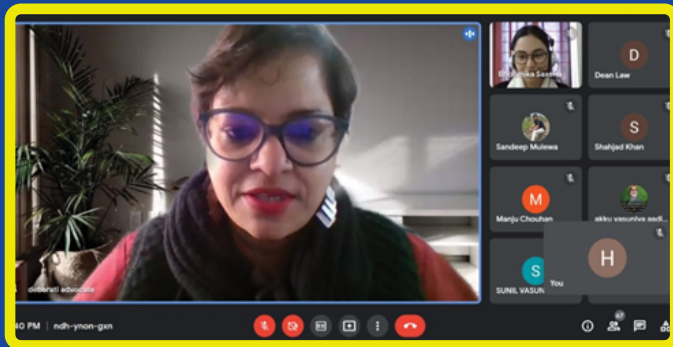

ONE DAY ENTREPRENEURSHIP AWARENESS PROGRAM (EAP/IMC)

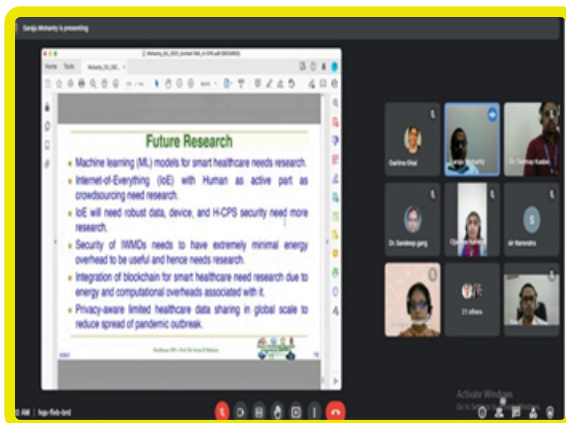
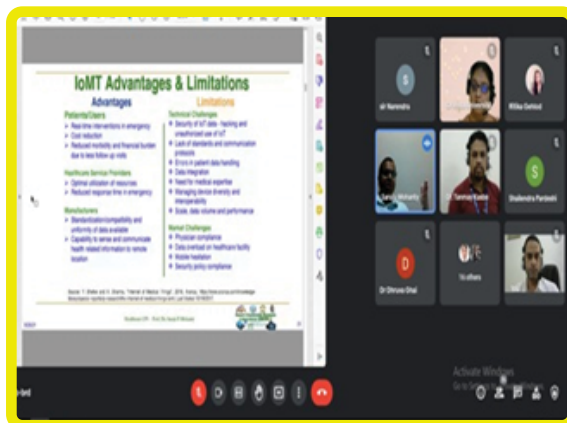


Oriental University Indore's incubation center organized a "One Day Entrepreneurship Awareness Program" with MSME-Development Institute, Indore.

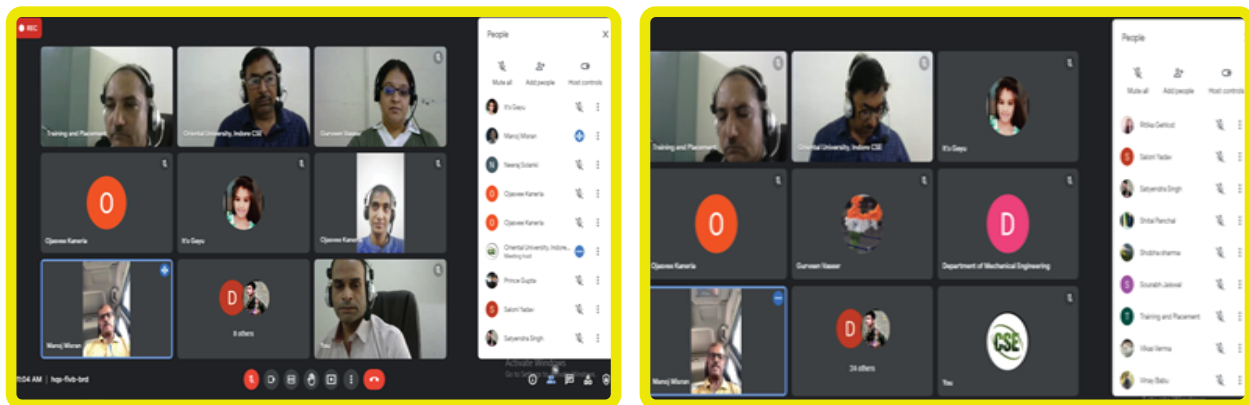

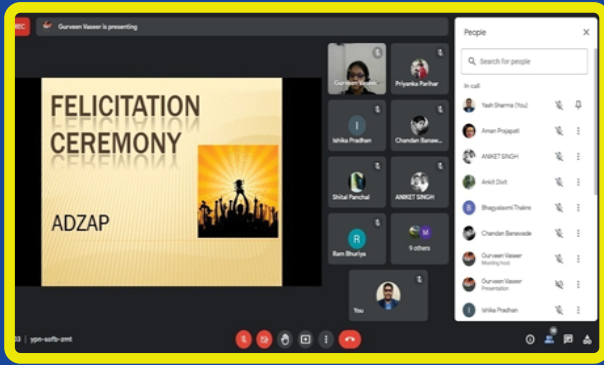
WEBINAR ON “CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES IN IT INDUSTRIES”

Department of Civil Engineering organized Industrial Training Programme in TATA Steels, Indore.

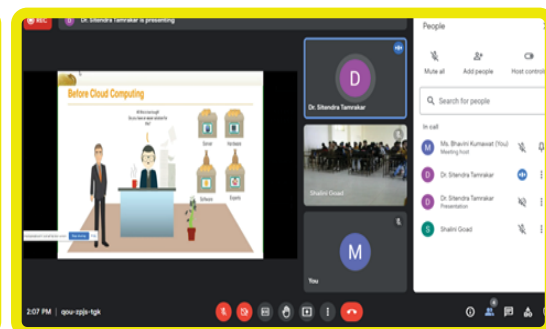
This was especially arranged for B. Tech., M. Tech., and Diploma students.

It was an interactive session where basics of cloud computing, server model, cloud computing fit to everyday life and cloud development models were discussed. Student’s queries were also solved.



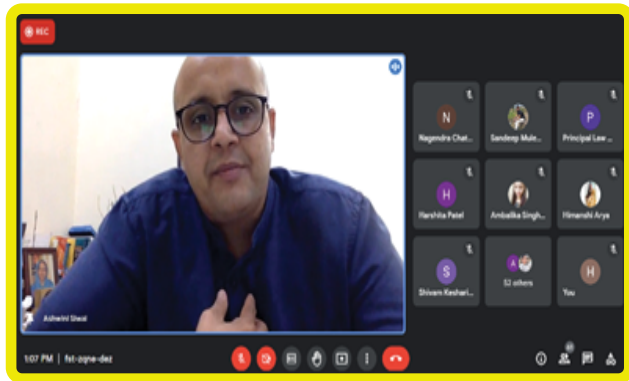

Students got in-depth knowledge of copyright and patent law.

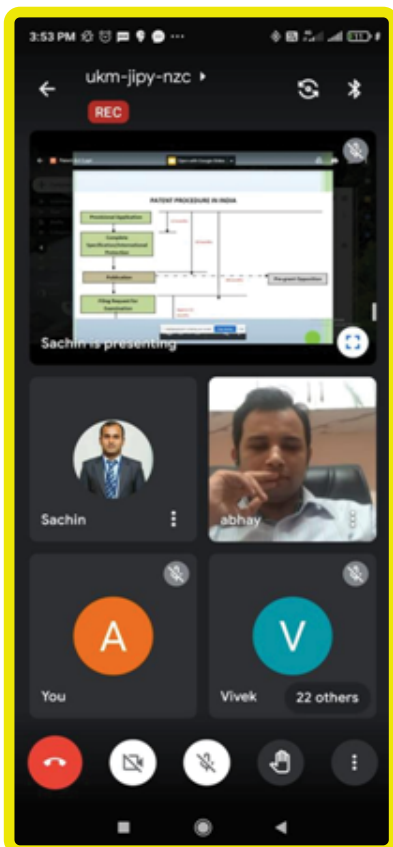


LEGAL AWARENESS WALK

Students also interacted with the Paralegal Transgender Volunteers of NALSA where students got insights on using the machinery of Lok Adalat and Mediation.



WEBINAR ON PATENT AND COPYRIGHT

The Guest Speaker for this Webinar was Mr. Abhay Lunia, Asst. Professor, Jagran Lakecity University, Bhopal. He talked to students about Copyright as a form of protection for original works of authorship that is "fixed in a tangible medium of expression." The Copyright Act of 1957 grants the owners exclusive right to reproduce the work, an exclusive right to distribute the work, and the exclusive right to perform or display the work.

He also talked about the “patent” which is a grant to an inventor that allows the inventor to monopolize the manufacture, use, sale, and importation of an invention. This right lasts a limited time and gives the patent owner the right to recover damages in a lawsuit against an infringer.

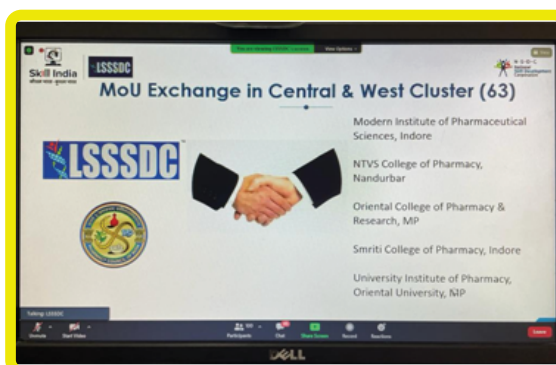

WORLD CONGRESS ON “DRUG DISCOVERY & ADVANCES IN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES”

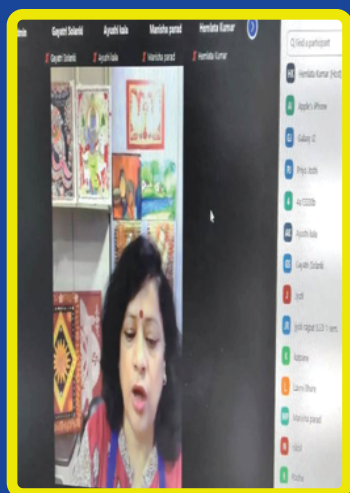
