7.1.5 Green Campus Initiatives:

Response:

Oriental University Indore has always advocated for creating and maintaining a green campus. The university minimizes the use of plastic, believes in recycling and reusing of the waste materials as much as possible and encourages sustainable and eco-friendly practices in all areas of campus.

1. Restricted Entry of Automobiles

At present, parking facilities have been provided to the selected parking areas only, and automobiles are restricted in the main university areas. Each visitor's vehicle license number is recorded in the visitors' entry register at the main gate of the university and efforts are being made to reduce pollution on campus.

For the future, a proper parking system for automobiles has been planned for restricted entry of automobiles in the university campus.

2. Use of Bicycles/Battery Powered Vehicles

Use of bicycles has been planned in the restricted areas of university. In the campus, battery-operated vehicles were introduced in 2023. Through this initiative, the University has adopted a green culture and promotes a greener ecosystem along with providing pollution-free living conditions for its residents.

Having battery powered vehicles installed on campus will allow the University to go one step forward in trying to be on par with the Government of India's efforts to promote renewable energy sources. It facilitates transportation for university members on campus, and it is helpful for all residents. The two Battery Powered Vehicles (One is 8 seater and another is 6 seater) has been purchased by the university.




Figure.3: Purchase Order for Battery Powered Vehicles

3. Pedestrian Friendly Pathways

In university, in different locations, pedestrian friendly pathways are constructed, due to which students/faculty members/staff members, etc. can move from one to other places(s) easily. These pathways connect, main teaching blocks to hostels, mess, canteen, and residency. There are concrete boundaries and painted lines on either side of the roads. Maintenance is carried out on these roads regularly to prevent mud, dust, and vegetation from growing on them. University campuses are made even more beautiful by these well-maintained roads.










Figure.4: Pedestrian Friendly Pathways

Figure.5: Stickers recommending the Ban on Plastic






Figure.6: Events recommending the restricted use of Plastic




Figure.8: Landscaping at Oriental University, Indore




Figure.9: Plan for Greenery at Oriental University, Indore
